GETTING STARTED

PlayStation®3 system

Starting a game: Before use, carefully read the instructions supplied with the PS3™ computer entertainment system. The documentation contains information on setting up and using your system as well as important safety information.

Check that the MAIN POWER switch (located on the system rear) is turned on. Insert the RESIDENT EVIL® Operation Raccoon City disc with the label facing up into the disc slot. Select the icon for the software title under [Game] in the PS3™ system's home menu, and then press the  button. Refer to this manual for information on using the software.

Quitting a game: During gameplay, press and hold down the PS button on the wireless controller for at least 2 seconds. Then select "Quit Game" from the screen that is displayed.

Hint

To remove a disc, touch the eject button after quitting the game.



Trophies: Earn, compare and share trophies that you earn by making specific in-game accomplishments. Trophies access requires a PlayStation®Network account.

Main Menu

VERSUS

In Versus, you will compete against other players online according to a set of rules. There are numerous rules from which you can choose.

LEADERBOARDS

Compare your scores from Campaign and Versus with other players online.

OPTIONS

You can adjust the game's audio, controls and other gameplay options here. You can also press the START button during gameplay to access the Options.

DOWNLOADABLE CONTENT

Connect to PlayStation® Network to download additional content.

GALLERY

By saving items linked with Umbrella found within the Campaign more to your in-game PC, you will be able to view developmental materials such as concept art.

CREDITS

AUTOSAVE

RESIDENT EVIL Operation Raccoon City uses an Autosave system.

1 Player Character

The character controlled by the player.

2 MiniMap

A map that shows your surrounding area. Teammates and enemies will appear as icons.

3 Player Information

Information regarding your health, abilities, and ammunition. [See next page for details.](#)

4 Item Information

Information regarding your items and type of grenade selected. [See next page for details.](#)

5 Objective (Destination Icon)

Displays your next objective as an icon. The distance is shown numerically.

6 Mission Information

Displays information regarding your mission.

You can press the SELECT button during gameplay to check mission information.



PLAYER INFORMATION

- 1 Player health.
- 2 Displays chosen ability and if it is available or not. (Ability Gauge)
- 3 Remaining ammunition.
- 4 Ammunition equipped in current weapon.

ABILITIES

In *RESIDENT EVIL Operation Raccoon City* each character has a unique ability (special skill) assigned to them.

Some abilities are useful in combat, while others are useful for gathering information. You can use experience (XP) earned in-game to obtain new abilities.

ITEM INFORMATION

Displayed in the space of the directional buttons each item is assigned to a different direction.



- 1 Vision Ability (directional buttons: up to toggle)
- 2 Number and type of grenades (directional buttons: right to toggle)
- 3 Number of Antiviral Sprays (directional buttons: down to use)
- 4 Number of First Aid Sprays (direction buttons: left to use)

System.

INFECTION

If a player is attacked by a creature, they may become infected with the T-Virus.

If you contact the virus and lose all your health, you will become a zombie.

Once a zombie, the player becomes uncontrollable. You must either be killed or wait to recover.

* You can use Antiviral Spray or certain abilities to recover from an infection.



Once infected...

...and the player's health runs out, they will become a zombie and...

...you may have to take out your own teammate.

BLOOD FRENZY

Players and enemy soldiers who have sustained a large amount of damage will start to bleed, triggering a "Blood Frenzy". Zombies will catch on to the scent of blood and start excitedly attacking.

Cause enemy soldiers to bleed in order to bait zombies into attacking them.



If you are bleeding...



...zombies will be driven into a frenzy.

COVER

Get close to garbage cans and cars located on the map to use them as cover.

You can use weapons and grenades to attack while taking cover.



DIVING

You can use the left stick and the \otimes button to dive in various directions.

While diving press \square R1 to shoot your weapon.



QUICK DRAW

Hold \square L2 to equip your handgun.

Press the right stick in any direction to automatically shoot at enemies.

You may use \square R1 to shoot as well.



Close Quarter Combat

MELEE ATTACK

Press the **○** button to perform a melee attack

Press the **○** button repeatedly to perform a combo.

Use the left stick while press the **○** button to direct your melee attack towards any direction.



BRUTAL KILL

If you've knocked an enemy off-balance with a melee attack, press the **⊗** button to perform a brutal kill. You will finish the enemy off with one blow, but be careful, as you will be defenseless while performing it.

Press the **△** button while your Ability Gauge is maxed out to perform a brutal kill specific to your character.

*In addition, this will also use your ability gauge and you will be unable to perform an ability for a short period of time.



TACKLE

While sprinting, press the **○** button to perform a tackle.

Tackles will knock human-sized enemies to the ground. It is an effective way to force your way through a group of zombies.



ZOMBIE SHIELD

If you've knocked a zombie off-balance with a melee attack, hold the **○** button to grab the zombie and use them as a shield. This is an effective way to shield yourself from frontal attacks.



Pressing certain buttons while using a zombie shield will result in various actions.

*If the enemy is human, you will perform a special CQC.

Multi Play

CAMPAIGN

If online, you can play a co-op version of the Campaign with other players.

VERSUS

TEAM ATTACK

Players split into U.S.S and SPEC OPS teams and try to score points. You earn points by killing creatures and enemy players. The team that either reaches the point limit or has more points when time runs out wins.

BIOHAZARD

Earn points by retrieving samples of the G-Virus and returning them to your area. The team that reached the point limit first wins.


HEROES

Players control Hero Characters from various games in the Resident Evil series. The team that kills all of the opposing team's characters wins.

SURVIVOR

Each team must cooperate to survive until a rescue helicopter arrives. There are a limited number of seats on the rescue helicopter so you may have to outwit your teammates.

SQUAD SELECTION

Press the  button on the Main Menu to display the squad selection screen.

You can invite users you've registered as friend from this screen.



QUICK MATCH

If you select QUICK MATCH, you will automatically be placed in an online game.
